

IS MY BUSINESS REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED WITH THE COUNTY'S WEIGHTS AND MEASURES OFFICE?

WHEN A BUSINESS OPERATES COMMERCIAL WEIGHING OR MEASURING DEVICES, PRICE SCANNER, OR PACKAGES CONSUMER PRODUCTS, THOSE DEVICES MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE RIVERSIDE AGRICULTURAL COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE /WEIGHTS AND MEASURES DEPARTMENT.

Do you...?

Operate Commercial Weighing or Measuring Devices?

- **Scales**
(ex. Meat, produce, counter, food items, etc.)
- **Meters**
(ex. Water, oil, mileage, electric charge, etc.)
- **Linear measures**
(ex. Fabric, cordage, wire, etc.)
- **Volumetric dispensers**
(ex. Motor fuel, propane, hydrogen gas, natural gas, etc.)

Use a Price Scanner at customer check-out? Or, a...

- **Price look-up system or**
- **Point-of-sale system or**
- **Computerized Pricing System**

Package Consumer Products?

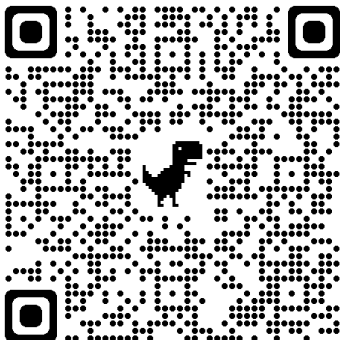
- Meat packages, bakery packages, other food items, consumer or household goods, soil, rock, fertilizer, etc.
