TO: PEST CONTROL BUSINESSES WORKING WITHIN RIVERSIDE COUNTY

REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR 2025 (Office hours for Registration are from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM)

<u>PEST CONTROL BUSINESSES</u>: Please complete and sign both the registration form and the equipment registration form. The registration fee is \$60.00. Make a check payable to the <u>County of Riverside</u>. Send the registration fee, the completed forms, and a copy of your 2025 Agricultural Pest Control Business License to the Agricultural Commissioner's Office in Riverside. Note: for <u>each</u> branch office, a <u>separate</u> registration is required as well as an additional \$60.00 fee. The registration fee for *Maintenance Gardener Pest Control Businesses* is \$25.00. *For your convenience you can now pay online (a) www.rivcoawm.org*

Please note that we will no longer be accepting monthly summary pesticide use reports with both agricultural use and structural use on one form. Please submit 2 separate reports. <u>Pesticide use reports may be submitted</u> <u>electronically</u> instead of submitting paper copies; for further information, please contact one of our offices. If you are also applying for a 2025 Restricted Materials Permit, please <u>call-in advance to schedule an</u> <u>appointment</u> (office hours for Permit issuance are from 8am to 3 pm).

If you have applied for a 2024 or year 2025 license card and have not received it, please contact the Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) prior to registering with Riverside County. <u>No registrations will be processed</u> without a valid license and work may not be performed until registration occurs.

All mail must go to P.O. Box 1089, Riverside CA 92502-1089 or it will be returned.

IF FEES ARE PAID ONLINE, REGISTRATION FORMS ARE STILL REQUIRED TO BE SUBMITTED TO OUR OFFICE. BEGINNING 2021/22, THE AGRICULTURAL COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE WILL NO LONGER BE MAILING COURTESY REGISTRATION FORMS.
